- Apply and receive your student ID number
 - Be sure to be in touch with your enrollment counselor to periodically check on the status of your application
- Send official transcripts and documents
- Send official copies of your JST or CCAF
- Complete forms through Vets.gov
 - Click Educational Benefits
 - Scroll down to drop-down menu and answer questions accordingly
 - Once the Apply Now button appears, click it and continue
- Complete FAFSA (fafsa.ed.gov)
Once accepted into the program:
- As a military service member or veteran, Drexel waives the \$100 matriculation fee
- Send Certificate of Eligibility and V-Cert to Drexel's certifying official. *(Please contact your appointed Military Enrollment Counselor for certifying official's information)*

Requesting your Joint Services Transcript or Community College of the Air Force Transcript

HOW TO REQUEST YOUR JOINT SERVICES TRANSCRIPT

- Visit the Joint Services Transcript website and register for an account
- Log in and select "Transcripts"
- Click "official transcript request", and enter "Drexel" as your school search phrase
- Click on the "Drexel University Online" link, and in the next screen click the check box. Then click "Yes."

HOW TO REQUEST YOUR COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE AIR FORCE TRANSCRIPT

- Visit the Air University website

You will see several options for ordering your transcripts:

- » **Credentials solutions:** This option requires a fee. Order through their site and select delivery via first class mail or Federal Express service. Tracking numbers are only offered when using the FedEx service. The Air Force does not cover these fees.
- » **Written request:** This option is free of charge. Written requests are processed in the order they are received (10-15 business days)
