Admissions Criteria

This program consists of 45 quarter credits. Admission to the program requires:

- Graduates of foreign schools must also have of 550 or higher in the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
- A completed application form
- Official transcripts from all universities and/or colleges attended
- Two letters of recommendation
- Personal essay
- Resume
