

**How transfer credits are applied:**

1. We take courses that are equivalent and apply them to Drexel courses.
2. We then convert the credit you earned on the semester basis and apply that to our courses here. Semesters credit hours x 1.5 = Quarter credit hours (Semesters = 15 weeks; Quarters = 10 weeks).
3. If any credits are left over, we tally those surplus credits to give you credit you've earned toward your 180 total credits.

**In order to graduate, you need to meet every required course listed here either at Drexel or through transfer credits AND you need to meet the 180 credit minimum.**
