Students can take courses part-time and have access to lectures, reading materials, assignments, exams and professors using a standard computer connected to the Internet. Our degree programs follow the same rigorous academic standards as those taught on-campus. The same admission standards apply and, in most cases, the same Drexel University faculty teaches.
